= Rite of passage (Ceremonies that mark important transitional periods in a person's life, such as birth, puberty, marriage, having children, and death)

Three strands -



**Theology** is about **believing**. Where beliefs come from, how they have changed over time, how they are applied differently in different contexts.



**Philosophy** is about thinking **(expressing)** – It's about finding out how and whether things make sense. It deals with questions of morality and ethics.

Human and social science = about living, explores the diverse ways in which people practise their beliefs

= Dharmic faith = Religions common to India and the subcontinent. (Hinduism. Sikhism and Jainism)

= Abrahamic faith =, are a group of monotheistic religions that strictly endorse worship of the God of Abraham (Christianity, Judaism, and Islam)
